- \* Use an approved insect repellent every time you go outside, and follow label instructions.
- \* Drain standing water where mosquitoes can breed.
- \* Wear long sleeves and pants when outside.
- \* Use air conditioning or make sure doors and windows are screened to keep mosquitoes outside.

## **Volunteers Needed for Boards and Commissions**

The City of Coppell annually seeks volunteers to serve on a number of city boards, commissions and, committees. To participate, volunteers must be at least a one-year resident of Coppell, a registered voter in Coppell, and must submit an application (applications are retained for a period of one year only and must be resubmitted annually). Applications were mailed to resident's homes, and are also available from the City's website at <a href="https://www.coppelltx.gov">www.coppelltx.gov</a>, at Town Center, and at the Cozby Public Library.

Board and commission members usually meet monthly on weeknights. Appointments are for one to two years depending on the board. Attendance is required in at least 75% of the regularly scheduled meetings in order to maintain a position on the boards. Applications filed the prior year will not be considered. # Reconstruction of Shadowcrest Ln. & Sandy Knoll Dr.

The City of Coppell is continuing with the neighborhood street revitalization projects authorized by the passage of the ¼ cent sales tax dedicated to street reconstruction. The City Council approved a contract with RKM Utility Services, Inc. at the July 8th City Council meeting for the reconstruction of Sandy Knoll Drive (Sandy Lake to Woodhurst) and Shadowcrest Lane (Moore Road to the west). Construction on these projects is anticipated to begin in August.
