



## Learn to Swim Scholarships – Information Sheet

Here in the City of Coppell, we strive to promote and perform at the highest level possible for our community. We do know that everyone deserves the opportunity to attend swim lessons that they may not have been able to attend in order to keep them safe in and around the water. This is why we offer a Learn to Swim scholarship program for our residents.

The scholarship for swim lessons only applies to the Learn to Swim group lesson program, for children ages 3-14 with little to no knowledge of swimming. The program is based on a first-come, first-served basis, when qualified. Scholarships are granted for three session or completion of the Beginner level, subject to availability at no cost.

We have a limited number of scholarships available each year and will do our best to distribute them in the best way possible. Please keep in mind that any information provided will be kept private and only viewed by the scholarship committee. The outcome of your submission will be taken into consideration for the scholarship and you will know within two weeks, if you qualify for the scholarship.

Swim lesson space is also depending on availability. Qualification does NOT guarantee a spot in the Learn to Swim program. Registration may take place as late as the first week of the session due to availability opening up.

### Criteria:

1. Must be a citizen of Coppell, and provide proof of residency through a current utility bill, tax bill or lease agreement.
2. Must meet income eligibility requirements. Please provide a copy of your 2018 Tax Return (Form 1040 or W-2). Please black out all social security numbers and other personal information.

### Sessions and Levels

Session 1: June 3<sup>rd</sup> – June 13<sup>th</sup>

Session 2: June 17<sup>th</sup> – June 27<sup>th</sup>

Session 3: July 1<sup>st</sup> – July 12<sup>th</sup>

Session 4: July 15<sup>th</sup> – July 25<sup>th</sup>

Session 5: July 29<sup>th</sup> – August 8<sup>th</sup> (AM only)

Preschool - Children will work on the basic fundamentals of swimming such as blowing bubbles, front and back floats, kicking, arm movements, and basic pool safety.

Beginner - This class is for the beginner swimmer and requires no prior experience. Skills taught in this level include front and back floats, front and back glides, elementary backstroke, front crawl, backstroke and pool safety. Some of the requirements to pass this level include 25 yards of front crawl, backstroke and elementary backstroke.

Please Note: Applying for or receiving a Learn to Swim scholarship does not guarantee swim lesson availability. Registration arrangements must be made with the Aquatics Manager to confirm registration.
